Bringing Transparency and Accountability Back to Washington

It is imperative that we get our nation's fiscal house in order and work to address our nation's debt and deficit. We must change the culture of "budgeting by crisis" in Washington by bringing transparency back to the federal spending process. This requires holding Members of Congress accountable, and I have authorized three bills to achieve this:

- The Stop on Schedule (SOS) Resolution - would force Bipartisan Point of Order to keep Congress in town until all 12 annual spending bills are passed, instead of adjourning for the August recess.
- The No Budget, No Pay Act - would prevent Members from being paid until we pass a budget.
- Reaction that Consequences Act - would withhold Congress Members' salaries if we do not pass regular appropriations bills before the end of the Fiscal year.

Ensuring Faith in Our Free and Fair Elections and Restoring the People's Voice

- End proxy voting and require Members of Congress to show up to get paid
- Ensure safe and fair elections through voter ID, accurate voter rolls, and observer access
- Prevent non-citizens from participating in our elections
